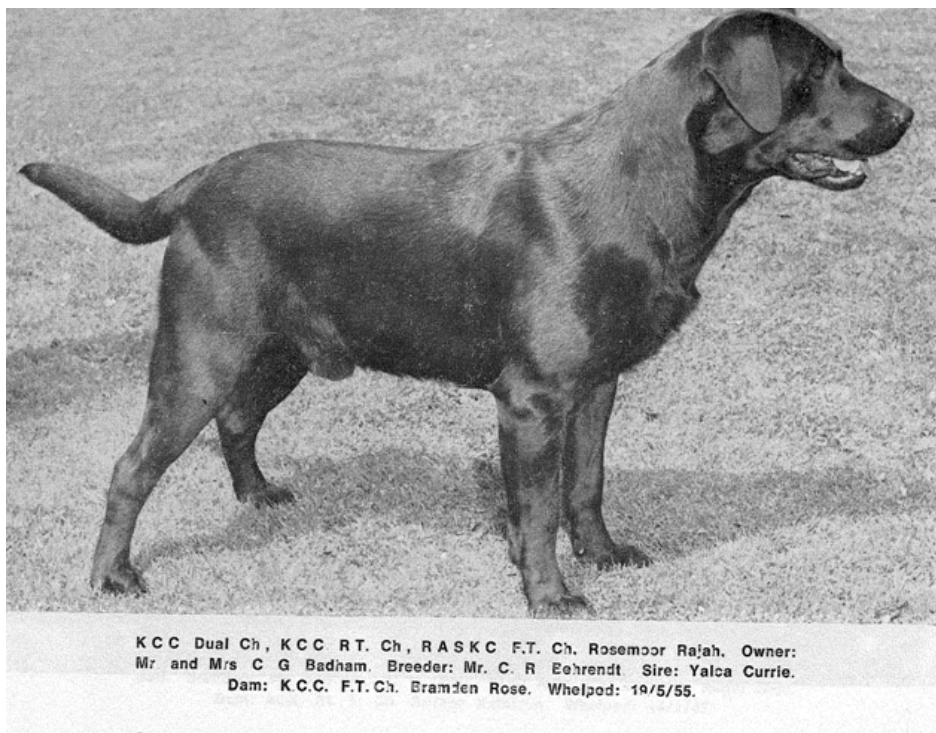

In Brief

Lab Club trials from 1957 to 1963 - Rajah competed in 9 of the RT's in that period and won 8 of them. He won plenty of others as well, in Vic and NSW. He then began competing in FT's. He gained RT and FT titles in both Vic and NSW. I had to talk Bill into showing Rajah and to his great surprise he won best Lab at Melb Royal and then a show title. He won the Robertshore Panther trophy for best dog in FT's and RT's from 1957-8 to 1961-2, then after winning the Woambra trophy for best in FT's, RT's and shows in 1960-61 & 1961-2, plus FT's and RT's in Vic and NSW, and the Bramden Elizabeth trophy for best in FT's and shows in 1961-62. Rajah was the first dog to achieve the K.C.C. R.T. Ch. title and then the three titles for Conformation, Field and Retrieving, which today would give the Tri Ch. title. He excelled in his day as an all round all purpose Labrador Retriever, showing all the attributes required in the breed. The Labrador Retriever Club of Victoria have an annual trophy named after this dog which is awarded to the best young working Labrador dog or bitch in Field and Retrieving Trials.
