During his outstanding trialling history Nicholas won 2 Diploma of Merit's and 3 Certificate of Merits for his outstanding work.

He was the only Utility Gundog to have won a State C/ship Retrieving Trial at that time. The only Utility Gundog to have won three State Championship Field Trials.

Nicholas was also shown a few times and took out Challenge Certificates in the show ring.

Nicholas was awarded the GSP Club's Dog of the Year award for Field & Retrieving Trials for six consecutive years from 1975 - 1979
