JC	Junior Courser	2 passes	Nil.	Prerequisite title for <u>all dogs</u> . Goes after dog's name.

SC	Senior Courser (Optional Title)	6 passes 4 different judges on 2 fields	Replaces JC after dog's name.	For Sighthounds competing in Singles, Open or Veteran Stakes, after attaining JC. Not a prerequisite for any other title.
sFCH	Singles Field Champion	10 passes 4 different judges	Replaces JC or SC and goes in front of dogs' name (prefix)	For Sighthounds competing in the Single Stakes, after attaining JC.
sLCM	Singles Lure Courser of Merit	8 passes	Replaces nothing, added after dog's name	For Sighthounds competing in the Single Stakes, after attaining sFCh.
sLCX	Singles Lure Courser Excellent	8 passes	Replaces sLCM	For Sighthounds competing in the Single Stakes, after attaining sLCM.
sLCX2 sLCX3 sLCX4 etc	Singles Lure Courser Excellent Multiplier Titles	8 passes for each level	Multiplier title – replaces sLCX or the previous multiplier with the relevant multiplier	For Sighthounds competing in Single Stakes, after attaining sLCX or relevant multiplier
FCH	Field Champion	100 points + 1 x First Place or 2 x Second Places 4 different judges on 2 fields	Replaces JC or SC and goes in front of dogs' name (prefix)	For Sighthounds competing in Open Stakes, after attaining JC.
LCM	Lure Courser of Merit	80 points +1 x First Place or 2 x Second places	Replaces nothing, added after dog's name	For Sighthounds competing in Field Champion Stakes.
LCX	Lure Courser Excellent	50 points +1 x First Place or 2 x Second places	Replaces LCM	For Sighthounds competing in Field Champion Stakes, after attaining LCM.
LCX2 LCX3 LCX4 etc	Lure Courser Excellent Multiplier Titles	8 passes for each level	Multiplier title – replaces LCX or the previous multiplier with the relevant multiplier	For Sighthounds competing in Field Champion Stakes, after attaining LCX or relevant multiplier
vFCH	Veteran Field Champion	75 points +1 x First Place or 2 x Second places 4 different judges on 2 fields	Replaces JC and goes in front of dog's name (prefix)	For Sighthounds competing the Veteran Stakes, after attaining JC.
vLCM	Veteran Lure Courser of Merit	30 points +1 x First Place or 2 x Second places	Replaces nothing, added after dog's name	For Sighthounds competing in Veteran Field Champion Stakes.
vLCX	Veteran Lure Courser Excellent	20 points +1 x First Place or 2 x Second places	Replaces vLCM	For Sighthounds competing in Veteran Field Champion Stakes, after attaining vLCM.
vLCX2 vLCX3 vLCX4 etc	Veteran Lure Courser Excellent Multiplier Titles	8 passes for each level	Multiplier title – replaces vLCX or the previous multiplier with the relevant multiplier	For Sighthounds competing in Veteran Field Champion Stakes, after attaining vLCX or relevant multiplier

<i>Coursing Ability Stream (all non-Sighthounds, includes all other Registered Breeds and ALL Associate and Sporting Register dogs including Associate Register ex Racing Greyhounds)</i>				
CA	Coursing Ability	8 passes 3 different judges	Replaces JC and goes after dog's name	For dogs competing in the Coursing Ability Stream, after attaining JC
CAA	Coursing Ability Advanced	8 passes 4 different judges	Replaces CA	For dogs competing in the Coursing Ability Stream, after attaining CA
CAX	Coursing Ability Excellent	8 passes 4 different judges	Replaces CAA	For dogs competing in the Coursing Ability Stream, after attaining CAA
CAM	Coursing Ability Master	8 passes 4 different judges on 2 fields	Replaces CAX	For dogs competing in the Coursing Ability Stream, after attaining CAX
CAM2, CAM3, CAM4 etc	Coursing Ability Master Multiplier Titles	8 passes for each level	Multiplier title – replaces CAM or the previous multiplier with the relevant multiplier	For dogs competing in the Coursing Ability Stream, after attaining CAM or relevant multiplier title.

NB - for all awards where a certain number of judges is required, the total may be made up of single judges, or combinations of judges, per the glossary of terms in the rule book.
